## I. Company Overview

BFA Systems, Incorporated, is a woman-owned small business headquartered in Huntsville, Alabama. The company was founded in May 2005 and has grown to over 30 employees, 29% of whom have a Masters Degree or higher. BFA Systems' facility is located in Cummings Research Park at 990 Explorer Drive, Suite B, Huntsville, Alabama 35806. The company has a Top Secret Facility Clearance and up to Secret safeguarding capability.

BFA Systems personnel have extensive experience supporting Verification and Validation (V&V) of large-scale models and simulations and hardware in the loop (HWIL) elements. BFA Systems is currently the technical lead V&V contractor providing a wide range of related support activities to SMDC for the Missile Defense System Exerciser (MDSE). We provide direct support to the Robotic Systems Joint Program Office (RSJPO) at Redstone Arsenal. Engineers provide support in the areas of program technical management, engineering, testing and logistics. Activities include specification development, documentation, on-site testing and maintenance of small, medium and large robotic systems. BFA Systems personnel have developed performance specifications, developed security classification guides, applied for frequency spectrum certifications, designed and recommended solutions to fielded systems, and have written numerous documents to ensure fielded systems can be safely and properly operated and maintained.

The company provides System Engineering support to the Joint Land Attack Cruise Missile Defense Elevated Netted Sensors (JLENS) system Project Office on-site at the government facility at Redstone Arsenal. This support includes the evaluation of the impact of other programs such as the Integrated Air and Missile Defense (IAMD) program, Navy Integrated Fire Control Architecture (NIFCA) program, and the Cooperative Engagement Capability (CEC) program on the JLENS requirements and performance. In addition, BFA Systems provides analysis of communications requirements to ensure compatibility with the Department of Defense Network Centric (Net-Centric) Key Performance Parameters (KPP).

BFA Systems has been involved in evaluation and assessment of various composite track managers for PEO Missiles and Space (PEOMS) in support of the Army Integrated Air and Missile Defense (AIAMD) architecture to develop enhanced weapon system functionality and enable more consistent track pictures. BFA engineers supported the Joint Architecture Working Group (JAWG) to define the component architecture to support a Single Integrated Air Picture (SIAP) and Integrated Fire Control (IFC) system.

BFA Systems, under award from the Missile Defense Agency Small Business Innovative Research award, performs highly complex model and simulation support for assessing lethality of high-explosive warheads. The Multi-Fragment Impact model is being developed and integrated into PEELS to provide fast-running results versus existing hydrocodes.
